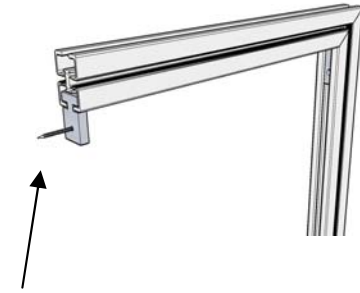

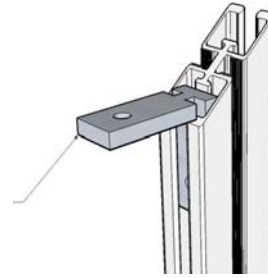
ISS Pole Installation

Guide for Semi Wall Mounting

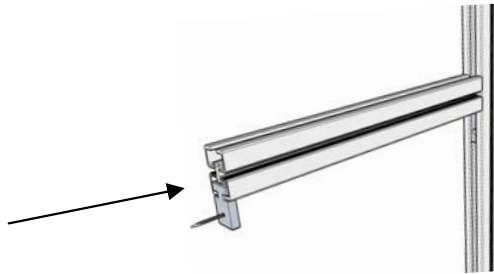


Top of pole mounts to wall using Tie Pole Kit and L-Bracket

Mitered Tie Pole Kit mounts to top of pole with L-Bracket



The lower ISS Tie Pole Kit mounts to inside of pole and attaches to the wall

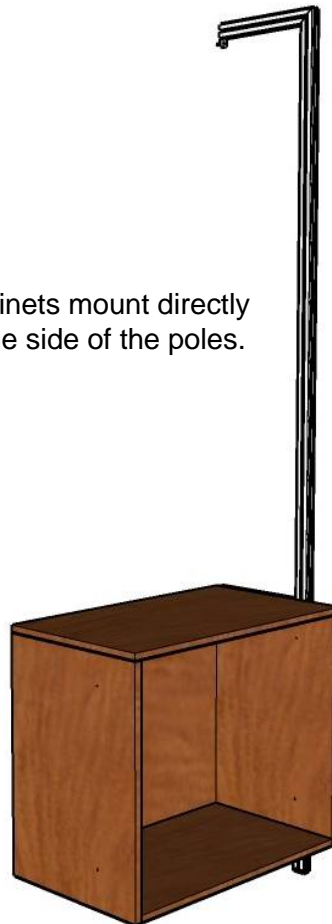


Each pole is secured to the wall in two places using tie pole kits.



Shelf brackets and bookends may be located at any point

Cabinets mount directly to the side of the poles.



Rubber bottom with 2 prongs

Proper ISS Pole Length:

ISS pole length is at least three inches from the ceiling or shorter.

Pole Installation:

1. Attach the tie pole kits to the ISS Pole using the L-Brackets and tightening the set screws.
2. The mitered kit goes on top. The location of the second tie pole kit is based on the design.
3. Position bottom of pole with rubber bottom into desired location and align the pole along the wall. (Brackets may need to be installed before attaching pole to wall)
4. Check and adjust pole location using a level to make sure it is plumb.
5. Secure to wall using screws and wall anchors if necessary.

Installing Brackets and Cabinets:

1. All ISS Brackets and ISS Bookends need to be inserted into the pole using the access slot in into the back or front channel in the proper order for top to bottom.
2. Fusion Brackets, Shelf End Supports and Loop Bookends may be installed after poles are in place. Threaded sides of the poles are for cabinet mounting using 1/4-20 screws.
3. On wall units, start at the bottom and add shelves upward. Cabinets will normally extend beyond the poles and attach towards the front. (ie. 18" deep cabinets attached 12" from the wall)
4. Confirm that the poles are plumb and that the shelves and cabinets are snug up against the wall. Secure shelves to brackets using #6 screws.
